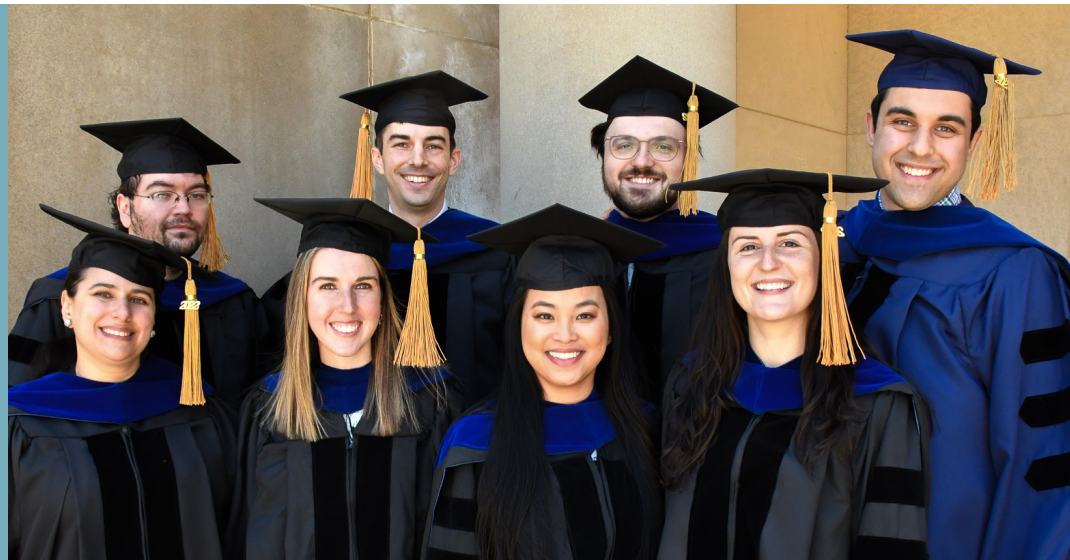

Criteria of Competitive Applicants

- MPH, or related MA/MS degree, with evidence of successful performance in three or more foundational areas of public health (Biostatistics, Epidemiology, Behavioral Sciences, Occupational and Environmental Health, Health Services Research).
- Exceptional applicants who lack foundational coursework will be expected to complete these classes for non-Ph.D. credit
- Academic performance in graduate courses (B or better)
- Strong research background: master's thesis, peer-reviewed publications, conference abstracts
- Personal essay and professional recommendations describing career goals, research experiences, and commitment to Public Health

Curriculum

60 required credits: 45 coursework, 15 dissertation research

Milestones

- General Examination after courses completed
- Research Proposal, External Review, and Oral Defense
- Dissertation Research and Oral Defense
